Variours activities organized during the program and near about 105 students particpated in this activities. Activities are as follows

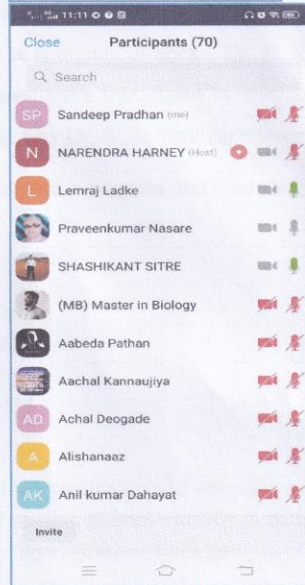
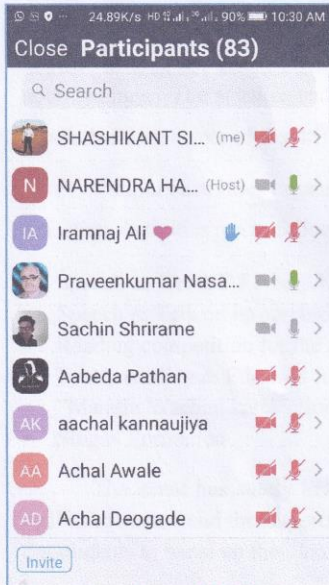
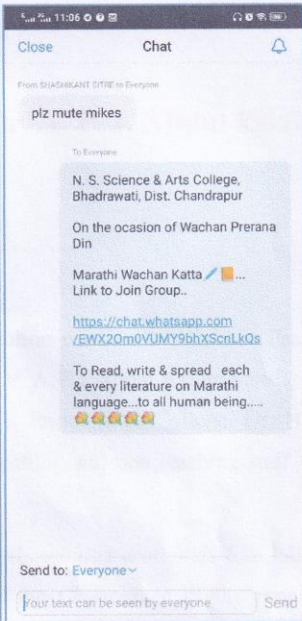
- Speech on Dr. A P J Abdul Kalams life

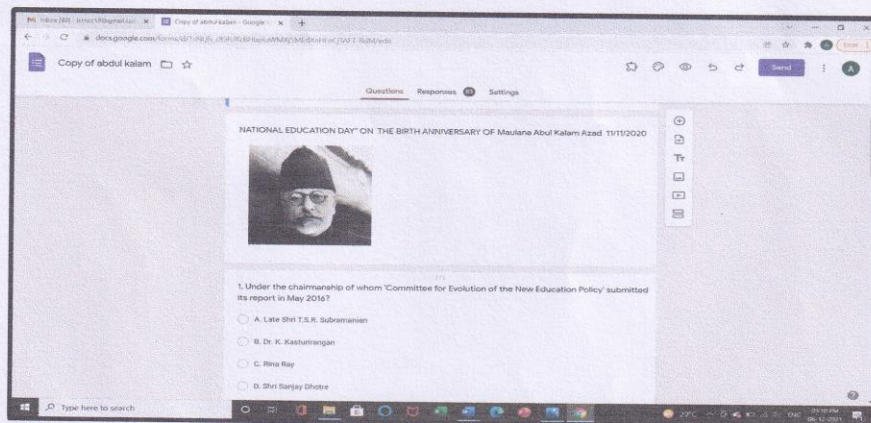
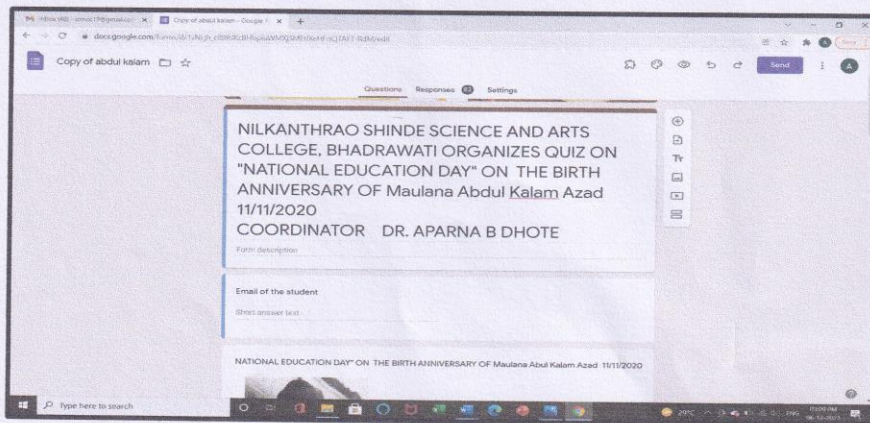

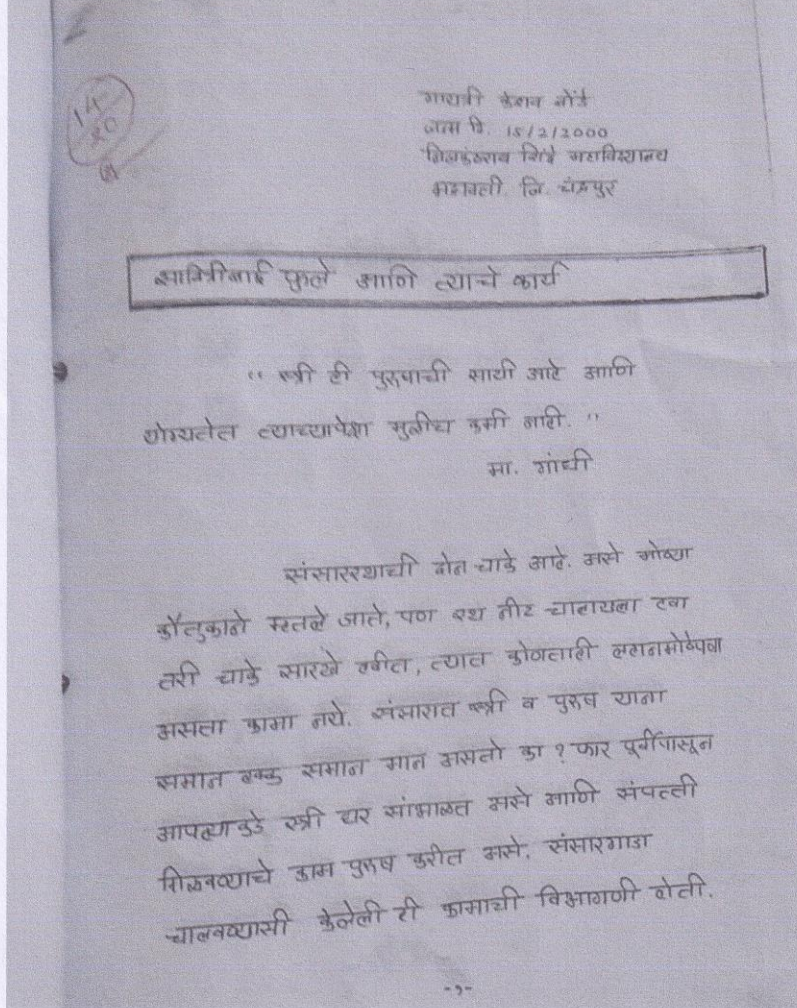

23rd January Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Birth Anniversary:

Online Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Birth Anniversary was celebrated . on this occasion Dr. L. s. Ladke , Principal express his views on Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. He told that Subhash Chandra Bose authored the book 'The Indian Struggle' which covers the Indian independence movement from 1920 to 1942. The book was banned by the British government. The INA supported the Japanese army in its invasion of northeast India and also took control of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. However, they were forced to retreat by the British forces following the Battles of Kohima and Imphal in 1944. Dr. Bedare told that Bose died of third-degree burns which he suffered in a plane crash in Taiwan on 18 August 1945. However, many in India refused to believe that he had died.

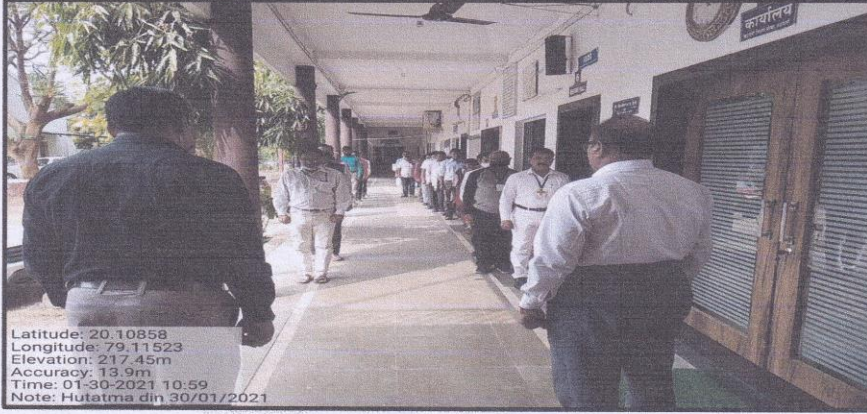
